Agrecovery's Small Bags Product Stewardship Scheme is a sustainable solution for recycling your seed, feed, and fertiliser plastic bags (25kg and under in size).

Eligible bags are FREE to recycle thanks to the support of the scheme's participating brand owners.

Bags must be made of either LDPE plastic (number 4) or Woven PP plastic (number 5) and meet eligibility criteria to be accepted.



WHAT IS PRODUCT STEWARDSHIP?

Product Stewardship is when manufacturers, brand owners, importers and retailers accept responsibility for reducing a product's environmental impact.

It is much more than just recycling. It's a whole lifecycle approach to products, starting with the design of the packaging, through to its use and subsequent disposal to ensure the smallest environmental footprint.

It's a move away from a linear - make, take and waste economy - to a circular one, where waste is recovered, recycled and reused.



WHAT HAPPENS TO THE SOFT PLASTIC WE RECOVER?

Due to infrastructure challenges in New Zealand, LDPE and Woven PP plastic bags are exported offshore where they are sustainably recycled into plastic pellets.

These pellets are then sold and used to make a number of useful items such as cables, vehicle parts and compost bins as part of the circular economy.



HOW TO TELL IF IT'S AN LDPE BAG

LDPE (Low Density Polyethylene) is a soft, flexible, lightweight, waterproof plastic material.

The Agrecovery liner you order is made from LDPE so you can recycle bags that look and feel like this.

It has the recycling code number 4.





HOW TO TELL IF IT'S A WOVEN PP BAG

Woven PP consists of polypropylene plastic threads that are woven together, creating a durable material with a great deal of flexibility and strength.

It has the recycling code number 5.

LDPE bags must be placed in the **GREEN** Agrecovery liner



WOVEN PP

Woven PP bags must be placed in the **PURPLE** Agrecovery liner.



PREP YOUR PLASTIC!

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR SMALL BAGS FOR RECYCLING

ORDER A LINER AND CODED ZIP TIE THROUGH AGRECOVERY



Zip ties have unique codes so the collection site can record your recycling in your Agrecovery account.



ENSURE THE TOPS
OF YOUR EMPTY
BAGS HAVE BEEN
FULLY OPENED



Fully remove the string or cut along the top of the bag to easily remove any excess residue.



TURN BAGS UPSIDE DOWN AND GIVE THEM A GOOD SHAKE



Ensure the bag is clean and free of residue, dirt and contamination - both inside and out.



BAGS MUST BE:

25kg and under in size

From participating brands only

Shaken clean (no product left inside the bag)

PUT THE CLEAN, EMPTY BAGS IN THE AGRECOVERY LINER SUPPLIED



Place empty bags in their correct corresponding liner. Full liners should fit between 60-100 bags.

Stored in a clean dry place (keep out of the weather).

No older than 6 months old (bags that have been stored for long periods,

Stored in an Agrecovery liner (green for LDPE, purple for Woven PP)

WHEN FULL, SEAL THE LINER WITH THE CODED ZIP TIE SUPPLIED



Store full liners in a dry, shaded location.
Liners should be dropped-off as soon as possible.



DROP YOUR FULL LINERS OFF AT YOUR NEAREST COLLECTION SITE



All bags and liners will be inspected by site staff to ensure acceptance criteria has been met.

BECOME AN AGRECOVERY MEMBER
